Ben Gosling runs the tape library (*Bendoteko*) from his home in Suffolk. It consists of more than 300 audio-cassettes of varying duration, and 18 video tapes. The recordings cover a wide range of subjects, offering great interest and entertainment: science, literature, philosophy, music and Esperanto.

EAB Members can purchase copies of the audio-cassettes for £3.00 each, including UK Postage and Packing, but if the order includes several short recordings, Ben will put them onto one cassette, wherever possible, to minimise the cost. Many cassettes have accompanying texts, which carry an additional charge of 5p per sheet. If the text is more than a few pages, Ben will advise you before charging.

Videos are available on monthly loan within the UK at a modest charge of £1.00 plus P&P.
